Peter has been a recreational fisherman for over 50 years, and has become a Rhode Island striped legend, going into the all-time R.I. record books for breaking the striped bass record in 2008 with a 76.14 lb. fish and again in 2011 with a 77.4 lb. monster bass.



RISAA Members Peter Vican and Don Smith are probably two of our most well-known members. They are a "matched set" of guys who just love to fish. During the fishing season they routinely land dozens of stripers over 30 pounds during the week (and

sometimes every night) because they know every inch of water and coastline around Block Island, and know how to put the right baits in the right place, at the right time, every time!

Education Chairman **Greg Vespe**, will moderate this seminar, bringing forth the candid questions that average anglers want to know. Come and hear Don and Peter talk about fishing for striped bass around Block Island over the decades. They will tell about how conditions change throughout the season and from year to year.
