The member will fill out the raffle form and winners will be chosen at the end of the meeting.

Why do Charter Captains off these trips?

In return for providing the trip, the charter captains that participate in the program get advertising space in the Newsletter, have their RISAA dues waived, and get a story of the trip written by an angler on that charter that gets published in the monthly RISAA Newsletter. Many captains use these stories on their web sites also.

Why do we choose a Group Leader and what do they do?

We choose a Group Leader because he/she is the point person for **all communication** between the winners and the charter captain. We optimally choose a member who has been on charters before and understands the protocols.

The Group Leader is also responsible for getting the story and pictures back to Steve Medeiros for publication in the newsletter within two weeks of the trip. That does not mean that he has to write it alone or take the pictures – this should be a team effort!

What are the responsibilities of the winners?

Have fun, catch fish! Communication is key! Let the group leader know if there are any issues. If you can't make the trip let the Alternate Coordinator (Gary Perschau) and the Group Leader know 7 days prior to sailing, or in the case of an emergency situation, as soon as possible. This information will be explained in the instructions issued to you upon winning.

What kinds of charters are offered?

Virtually every type of fish available in the local area is targeted. Every kind of angling - bottom fishing, trolling, top water, fly, and kayak - is offered. The areas fished range from the Providence to River to Coxes Ledge and even Stellwagen Bank.

Please take note of what is being offered. That way, if you have a physical limitation for kayaks or a strong preference for only one type of fishing, or the date that is not convenient, you may not want to participate in that raffle.

Remember all fishing charters are going to be weather permitting, they will all sail but the dates may vary a bit. Many of the charter captains present their fishing strategies at monthly seminars and at the Fishing Show.
