How To Catch **BIGGER** Fluke

featuring
Capt. Dave Monti

Capt. Dave Monti's presentation will feature a take-away list of his Top Ten Tips on how to catch bigger fluke.

The seminar includes a series of interviews with charter captains, fishing guides and expert fluke anglers. Strategies and tactics for fishing summer flounder in Bays and the ocean with maps and charts will be covered as well as rigs, jigs, baits and his favorite places to catch fluke.

Highlights of the presentation include Capt. Monti's "Fluke Cocktail", a rig and bait arrangement proven to catch larger fluke, as well as small bait presentations and the importance of flirting with that fluke until it is enticed to strike.

Captain Dave holds a master captain's license

and works as a charter fishing captain and guide on No Fluke Fishing Charters & Tours. He is 2nd vice president of RISAA active in fish policy serving as vice chair of the RI Marine Fisheries Council, is an American Saltwater Guides Association board member and active member of the RI Party & Charter Boat Association.



Captain Dave is the fishing columnist for the *Providence Journal*, *The Sun Chronicle* and eleven Massachusetts/Rhode Island weekly newspapers.

He is a regular contributor to the RISSA newsletter and the Marine Fish Conservation Network blog (www.conservefish.org/author/davemonti/).

Dave writes about the environment, fishing policy, regulations and ocean issues such as spatial planning, offshore wind, global warming as well as fishing tactics and conditions.
