**Marinated Fish with Sour
 Cream**

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound firm fish fillets, such as cod or haddock
- 1/2 cup oil
- 1/4 cup lemon juice
- 1 garlic clove
- 1 tablespoon minced onion
- 3 tablespoons chopped parsley
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon rind
- 1/2 teaspoon rosemary
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/2 cup flour
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 tablespoon grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- 1/2 cup sour cream

DIRECTIONS

- Marinate the fish fillets for several hours at room temperature in mixture of oil, lemon juice, onion, parsley, lemon rind, rosemary, salt and pepper.
- Dredge fish in flour mixed with salt and pepper, parmesan cheese and paprika.
- Fry fish in hot oil until brown, then lay in baking pan and spread with sour cream.
- Bake at 350° F until fish is done

Garnish with fresh parsley before serving, or add snipped chives to the sour cream before spreading over the fish
