**Two arrested for undersize black sea bass and scup**

Last week, after receiving a tip that poachers were keeping undersized fish along the bulkhead in the Port of Galilee, Environmental Police Officers from DEM’s Division of Law Enforcement conducted a patrol of the area.

After a period of surveillance, officers arrested two poachers and charged them with possession of undersized black sea bass, exceeding the daily limit of black sea bass, and possession of undersized scup.
